

Apprenticeship Overview & Application



The Open Roads Apprenticeship is an intensive job-training program in our bike shop designed for young people to gain essential career readiness skills.

Apprentices will be actively mentored by Open Roads staff in job skills needed to successfully run a bike shop. This includes learning the systems of a bicycle and receiving detailed explanations coupled with hands-on learning as well as appropriate customer service skills. When teens successfully complete the requirements of the Apprenticeship, they will have the full support of Open Roads in applying for future jobs. This includes resume development, interview skills, workplace etiquette, demonstration of skills and abilities, support in the application process, and serving as a reference.

Requirements:

- → Ages 14-17
- → Be available for at least 4 hours per week until 60 hours is complete.
- → Need to have the ability to function successfully in collaboration with others
 - Respectfully convey your thoughts and opinions and listen to other's
 - ◆ Conduct yourself with maturity in a professional environment
 - Demonstrate an openness and willingness to gain further professional skills
- → Be able to provide your own transportation to and from our workshop location at 1523 Riverview Drive in Kalamazoo
